### PRIVACY POLICY

Information pursuant to Art. 13 D.Lgs. of June 30<sup>th</sup>, 2003, No. 196 Code regarding the protection of personal data and Art. 14 of Regulation No. 679/2016 GDPR.

The personal data provided by the User will be placed in a secured computer database, so it can be used and accessed by our internal personal. The data will be managed only by R.P.E. srl, located in Via S. Ambrogio No. 3 in Carbonate (CO), Italy.

Pursuant to Art. 7 of the Legislative Decree of June 30<sup>th</sup>, 2003, No. 196 (Code regarding the protection of personal data) and Article 17 of Regulation no. 679/2016 GDPR, the User has the right to obtain confirmation of the existence of any personal data concerning him / her, even if not yet recorded, and their communication in intelligible form. Furthermore, the User has the right to obtain:

- the origin of personal data;
- the purpose and methods for processing this data;
- the logic applied in case of processing with the aid of electronic instruments;
- the identification details of the owner, of the managers and of the designated representative pursuant to Art. 5, Paragraph 2 of Legislative Decree 30/06/2003, No. 196;
- the subjects to whom the personal data may be communicated or who may become aware of it as appointed representative in the territory, managers or agents.

Furthermore, the User has the right to obtain:

- Update information, rectification or when required the integration of data;
- cancellation, convert to an anonymous format or block data processed unlawfully, including data whose custody is unnecessary for the purposes for which the data was collected or subsequently processed;
- the authentication that the operation referred to in the preceding points have been brought to the attention, also with regard to their content, of those to whom the data have been communicated or disseminated, except in the case where such fulfillment proves impossible or involves the use of resources manifestly disproportionate to the protected right.
- Finally, the User has the right to object, in whole or in part:
- for legitimate reasons, the processing of personal data concerning him or her, even if pertinent to the purpose of the collection;
